- Please dress modestly for all camp activities and as you travel from your lodging to the camp beach.

Before departing camp

- **Please pay your bill prior to departure. All accounts must be settled before leaving camp.**
- Sweep and/or vacuum your facility before departure.
- Place all trash in the wastebaskets.
- Place all used towels and washcloths on the bathroom floor. Any unused towels or washcloths should be left on the shelves.
- Please pull the blankets back on the beds that have been used. Do not strip or make them. Beds that are unused should be left as is.
- If you used one of the blankets or bedspreads, please do not put it back in the plastic bag. Leave it on the unmade bed and it will be laundered with the sheets and pillowcases.
- Please wash all dirty dishes, pots and pans that were used and put in proper cupboards and drawers. Place dishcloths and towels on the floor in the bathroom with the soiled bath towels and washcloths.
- Please return any item(s) borrowed from another cabin or room to the room or cabin it was taken from.
- Please report any damage to furniture or appliances in your room or cabin. Damage not reported may be billed to the last occupant of the cabin or room.

Reservation Policies

Individuals and groups using Little Eden Camp facilities will be subject to the following policies and guidelines:

1. **Reservations:** Reservations for use of the lodge or cabins shall be granted on a first-come, first-served basis, as space is available. Lodging options are available on a daily basis, seven days a week through the non-summer season. In order to confirm your reservation date on Little Eden's reservation calendar, a deposit is required.

2. **Deposit:** Individuals/groups have 14 days to send a deposit in while Little Eden tentatively holds their date. Deposits are non-refundable. Deposits not received within 14 days after making a reservation will result in an automatic termination of reservation. The deposit amounts are as follows:

Lodge: \$300.00

Pine Creek: \$150.00

Individual cabin/unit: \$50.00

3. **Cancellation Policy:** In the event of a cancellation, there is no additional charge if the cancellation takes place up to 180 days in advance of the retreat. If the cancellation takes place at any time within the 180 days prior to the retreat, the charge will be equal to 75% of the estimated attendance of lodging and meals. The estimated attendance will be based on the number of attendees anticipated prior to the retreat as discussed between the leader and Little Eden Camp.

4. **Lodge:** A minimum reservation of five rooms or minimum \$390 per night charge is required for overnight use of the Lodge. A group reserving ten or more rooms may book "exclusive use" of the Lodge. *Exclusive use* still allows Little Eden the option of offering food service to cabin guests in the camp's dining room.

5. **Tax exempt:** Tax exempt groups must have a

current Michigan Sales and Use Tax Certificate of Exemption (Form 3372) on file with the office or we must charge you 6% sales/use tax. A copy of form 3372 is available in the office for your use.

6. **Food service:** Food service will be available for groups of twenty or more people (excluding children ages 0-3), or when the combined total of all groups requesting food service is twenty or more. If groups requesting food service total less than twenty, each group will be responsible for its own food needs, or be charged for meals for twenty people. Food service is required for those using the lodge. Cooking in lodge rooms or use of the lodge kitchen by non-staff is not permitted.

a. Two weeks prior to arrival — If meals have been requested it is the responsibility of the leader of the group to inform the camp of the approximate number of people coming and times for each meal.

b. One week prior to arrival — The camp must be given exact numbers for lodging and meals. Groups will be charged either for the number of people served or for the number called in, whichever is greater.

7. **Check in/Check out:** Rooms and cabins will be available at 3 pm on the day of arrival. Checkout is at 11 am on the day of departure unless prior arrangements are made with the office.

8. **Payment:** Payment in full is due before departure unless prior arrangements have been made with the office. Even with prior arrangements, payment not received within ten days of departure will incur a *late fee penalty* of \$25 per week. Little Eden prefers cash or checks but does accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover.

Reservation Policies

It is the leader's responsibility to inform all members of the group the following policies:

Not Permitted: Little Eden Camp is a smoke-free environment. All alcoholic beverages, firearms, and fireworks are prohibited on the premises. Pets are not allowed on the grounds or in any building. Service dogs must be approved in advance of arrival at camp.

Decorations: Candles and other devices with open flames are not permitted in any of the buildings without prior consent of the Executive Director. When consent is given, any open flame must be attended at all times!

Help Protect The Environment: If you should choose not to use a bedspread or blanket, please place/leave it in a plastic bag. Doing so will help keep our prices lower and help protect the environment by reducing our laundry. Please do not put used blankets or bedspreads into the plastic bags.

Extra charges: Your group will be charged for any lodge rooms/cabins that are assigned to your group unless the office is notified

and they are locked by camp staff on the day of arrival.

Damages: Please report any damages to furniture, appliances, or the building to the office. For items needing repair or maintenance, please fill out the Maintenance Request form. Little Eden Camp reserves the right to levy a damage or cleaning charge to any group or individual for damages caused by decorations (tape, nail holes, etc.) or for inappropriate use or abuse of facilities, furniture, or equipment.

Before you leave: Please clean all rooms/cabins using the cleaning instructions found in the guest manual.

Violation of any of these policies may lead to the loss of your deposit and may affect future reservations at Little Eden as well.
